



Supporting and Assisting Independent Living (SAIL)

Family Continuity's SAIL Program is a community-based residential program serving at-risk adolescents ages 16 – 22. SAIL is a co-educational, transitional treatment program for youth moving to independent living. Residents earn increased independence by demonstrating a commitment to their individualized treatment plans, including an essential set of responsible activities.

Specific Services Offered

- ~ Educational assistance, including GED preparation
- ~ Assistance in college or military enrollment
- ~ Assistance in seeking employment
- ~ Budgeting and money-management training
- ~ Social and life skills training
- ~ Assistance in seeking housing

Referrals

Adolescents are referred to the SAIL Program through the Department of Children and Families and the Department of Mental Health.
